Copies of the award citations are available via multiple sources, but the wording is not consistent and most sources provide incorrect citations. The exact wording, based on research, is only in the original citation. This book includes the official account of their act of heroism. The author donates all profits he receives equally to the American Legion, the Disabled American Veterans, and the Veterans of Foreign Wars. Brian Blodgett is a retired U.S. Army Chief Warrant Officer who served one tour in northern Europe and visited many of the World War I battlefields. He is a professor of History and Military History at the American Public University System.
